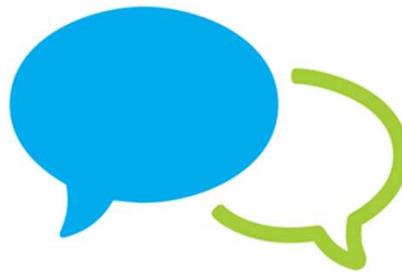

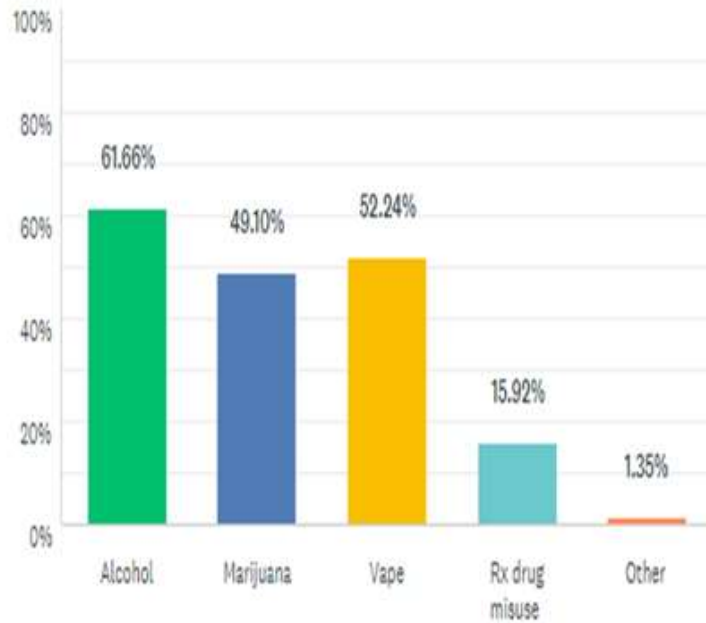

What do you think is the most widely used substance by youth in your community? (choose top 2)

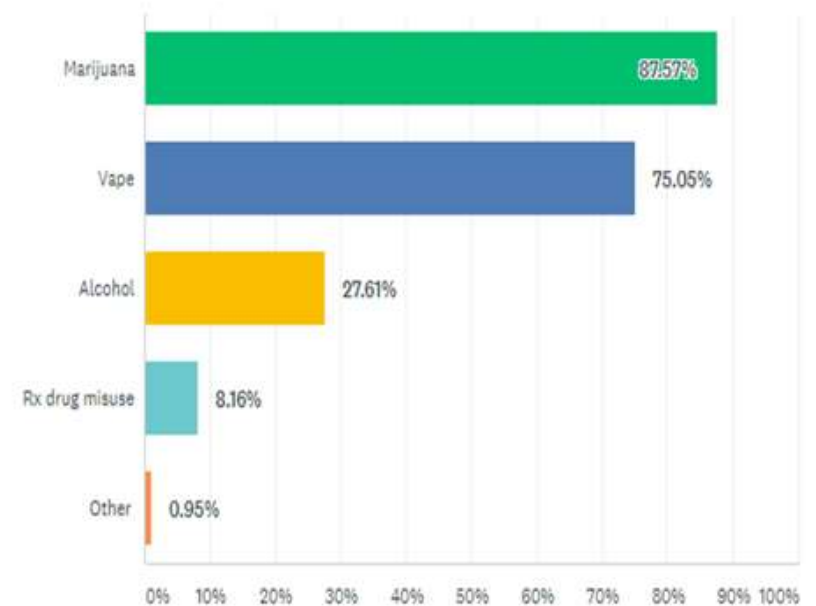

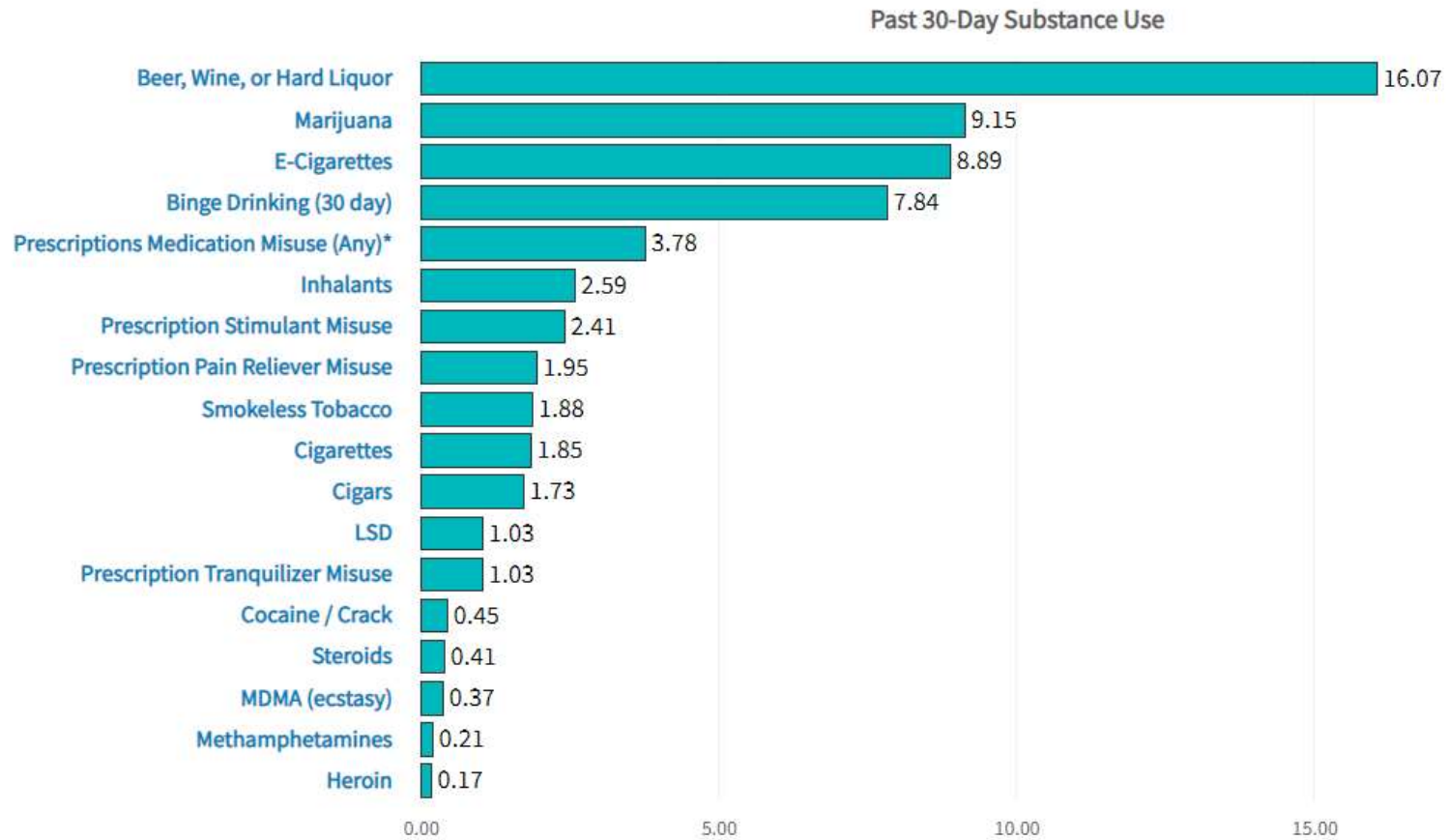

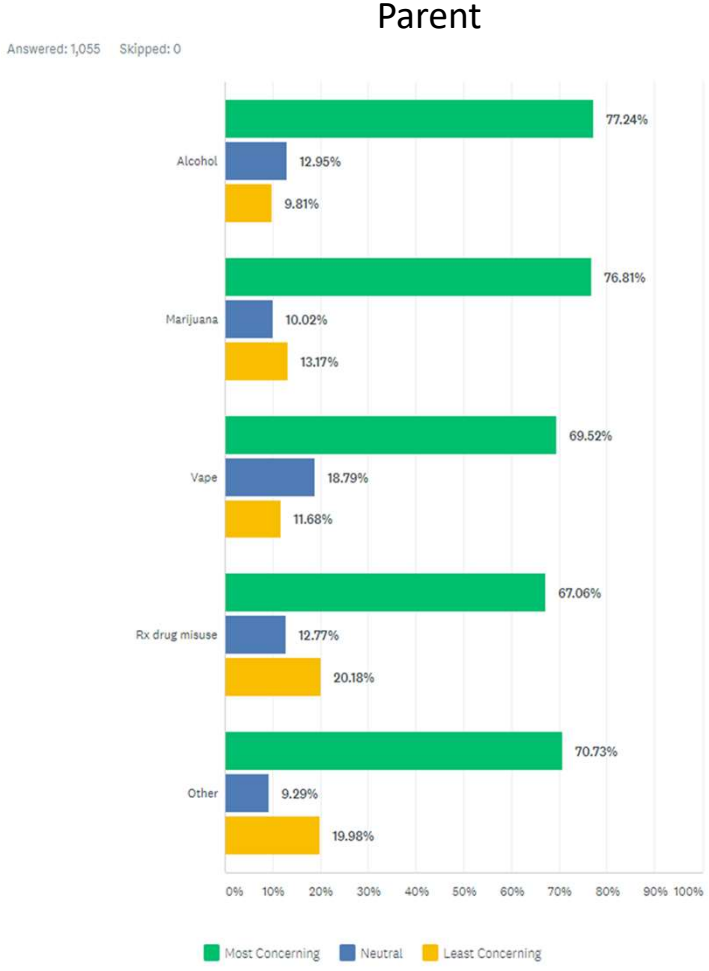

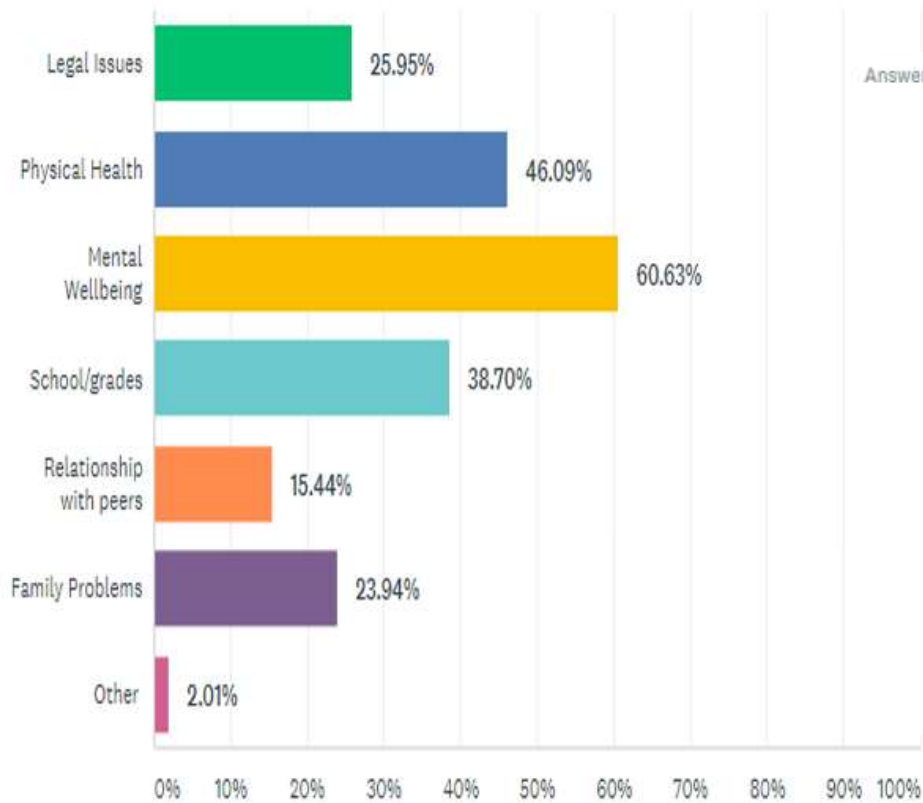
Which are the most concerning substances that youth are using in your community? (rate most to least)



What do you think are the most challenging issues that teens are facing regarding substance abuse? (choose the top 2)

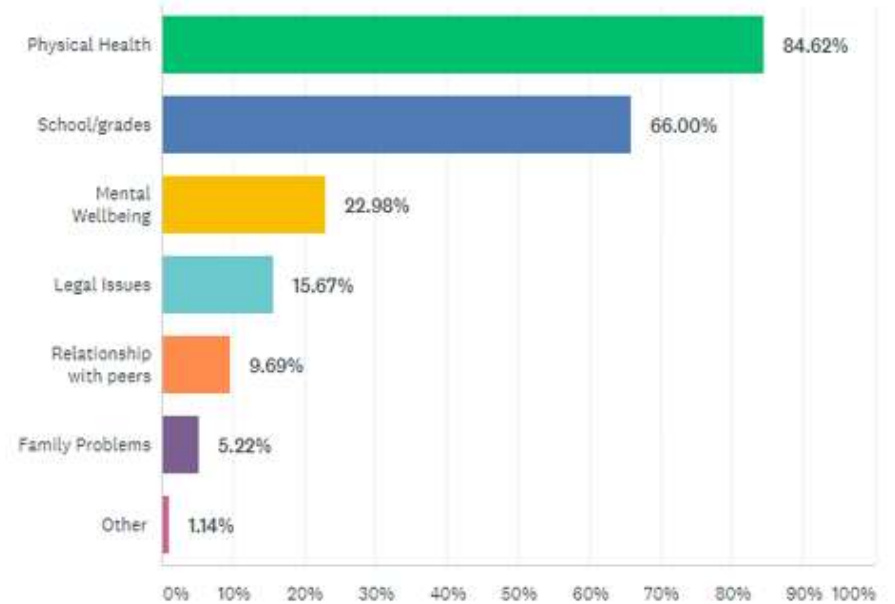

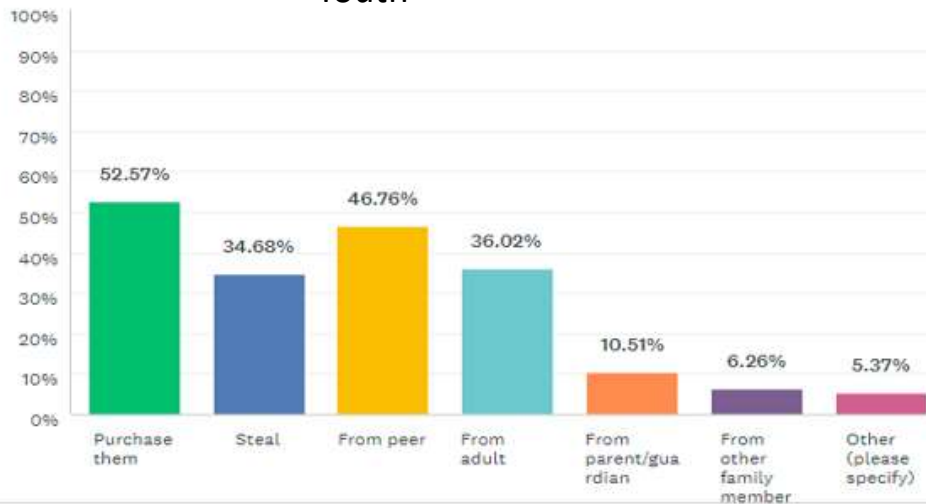

Where do youth typically get these substances? (choose 2)

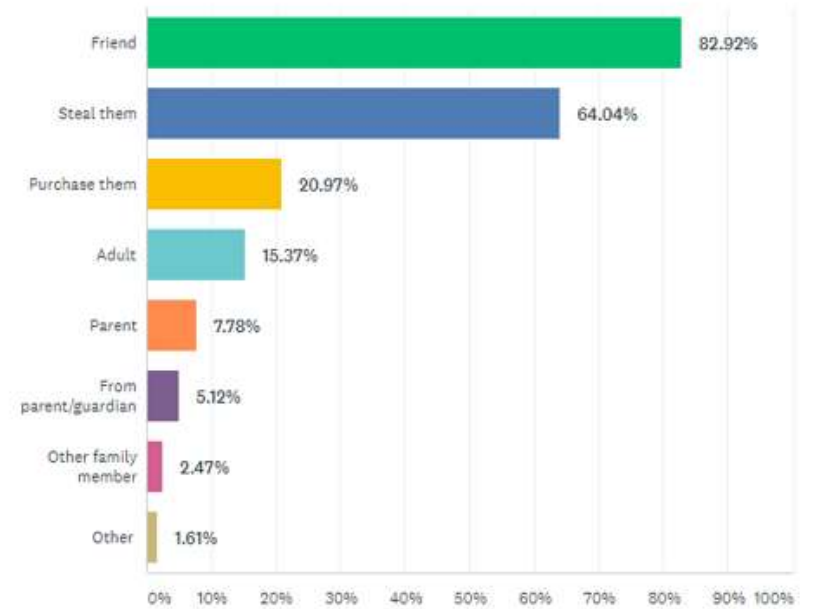

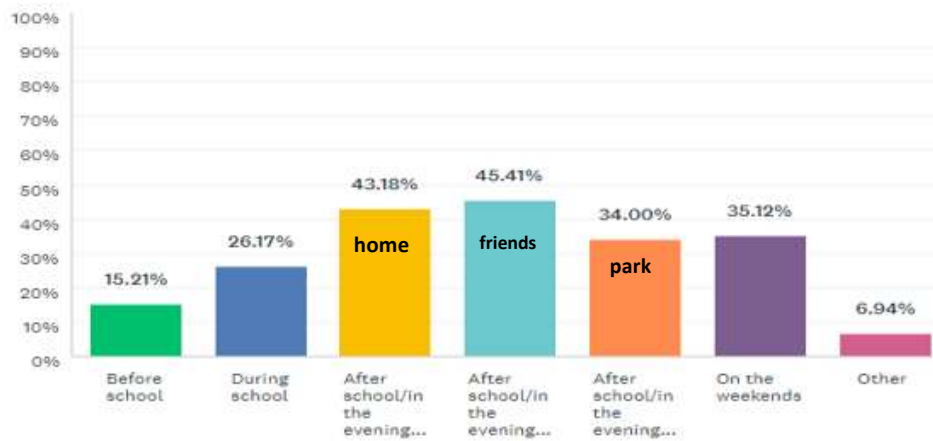

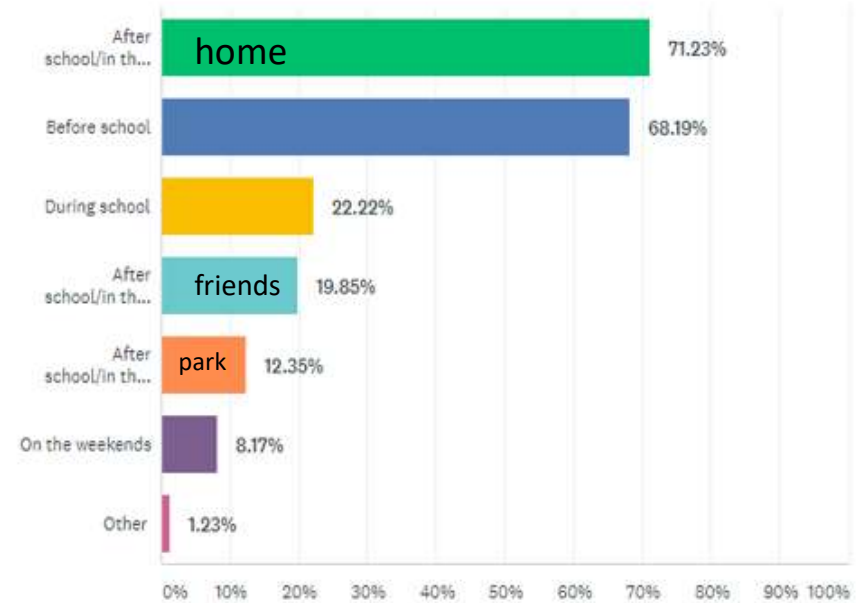

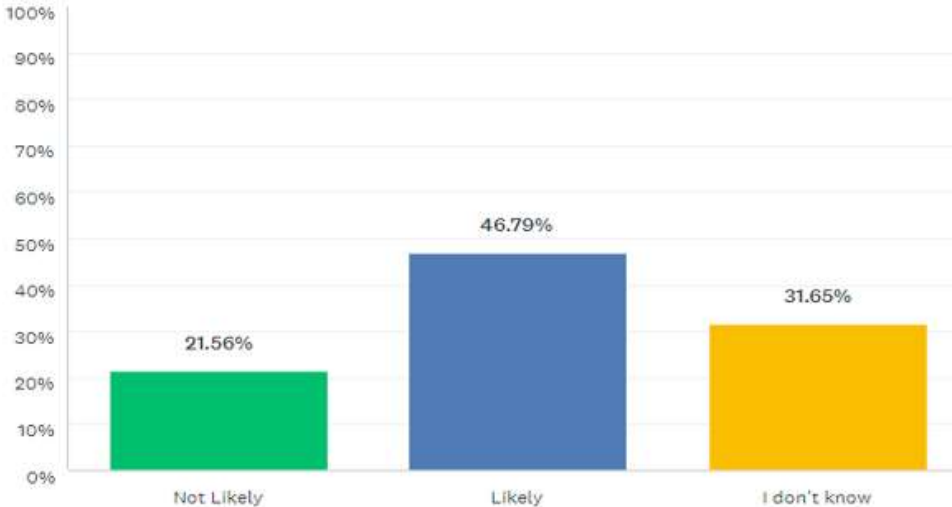

How likely are youth, who are using substances, to be caught?

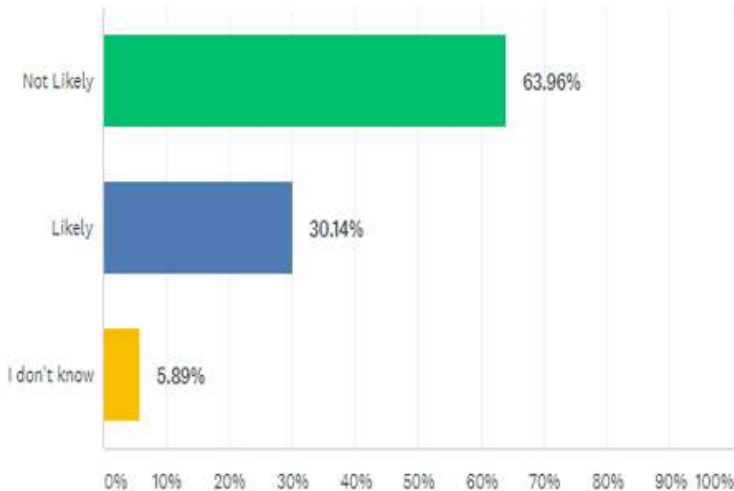

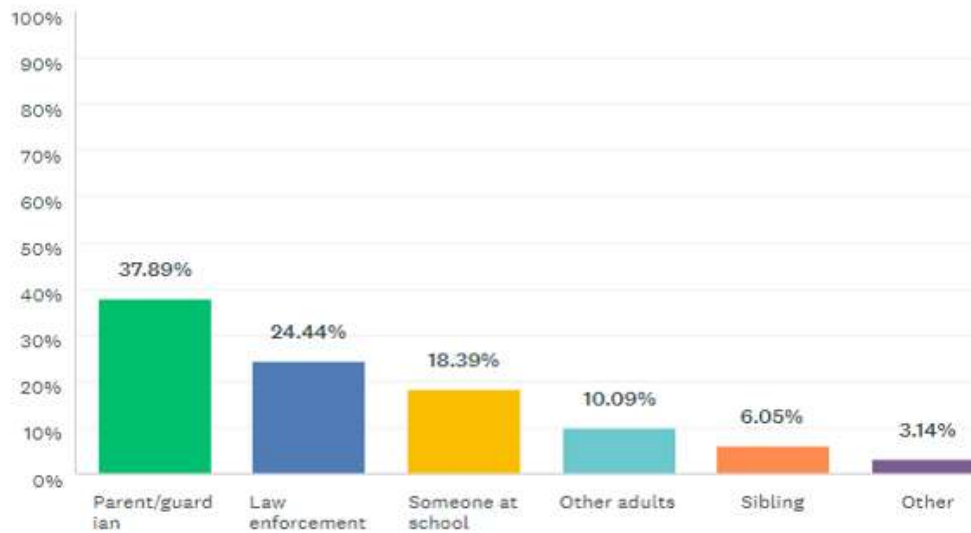

Who are they most likely to be caught by?

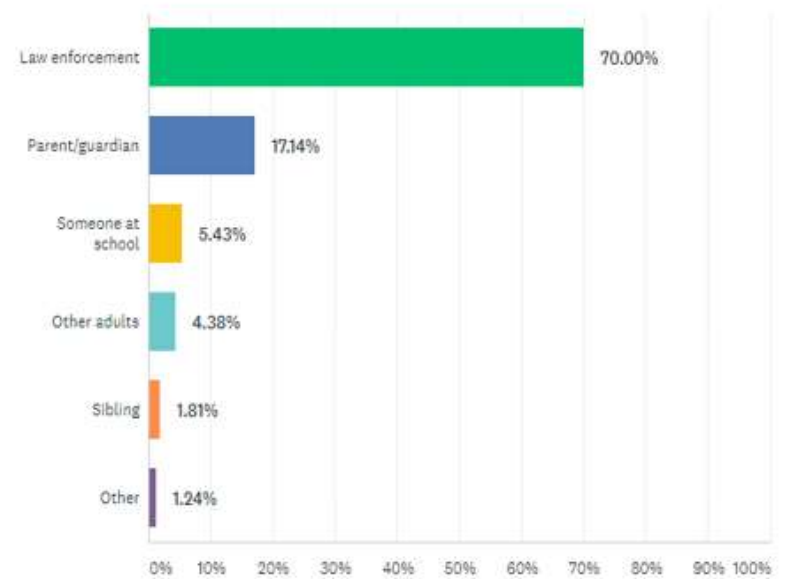

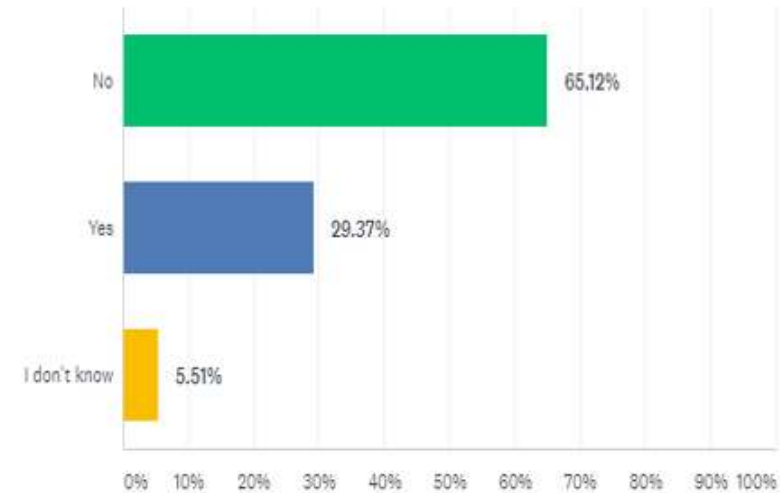

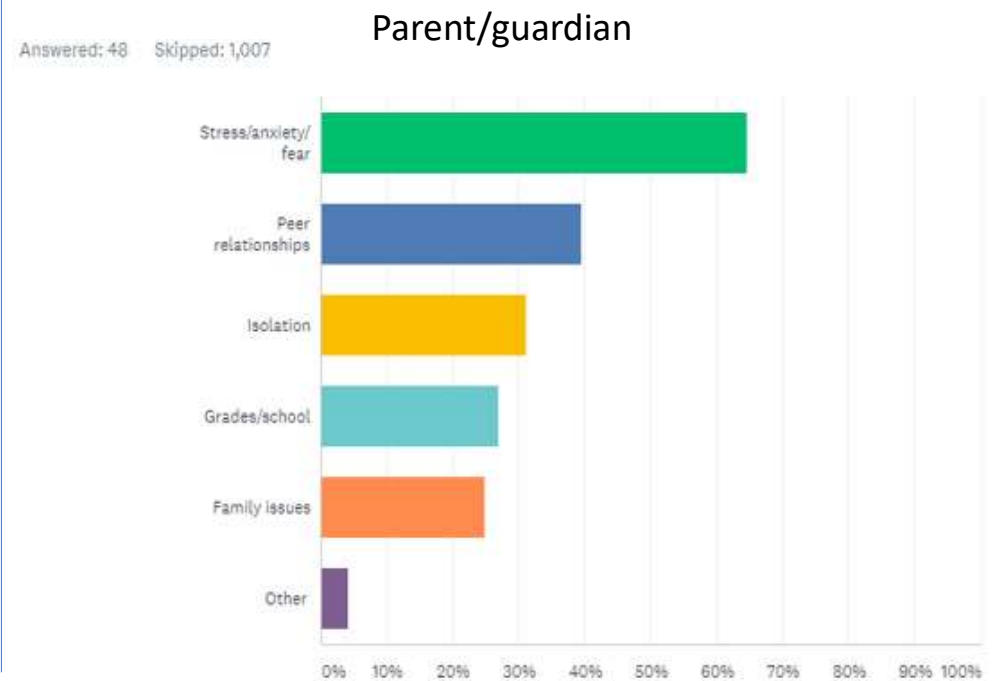
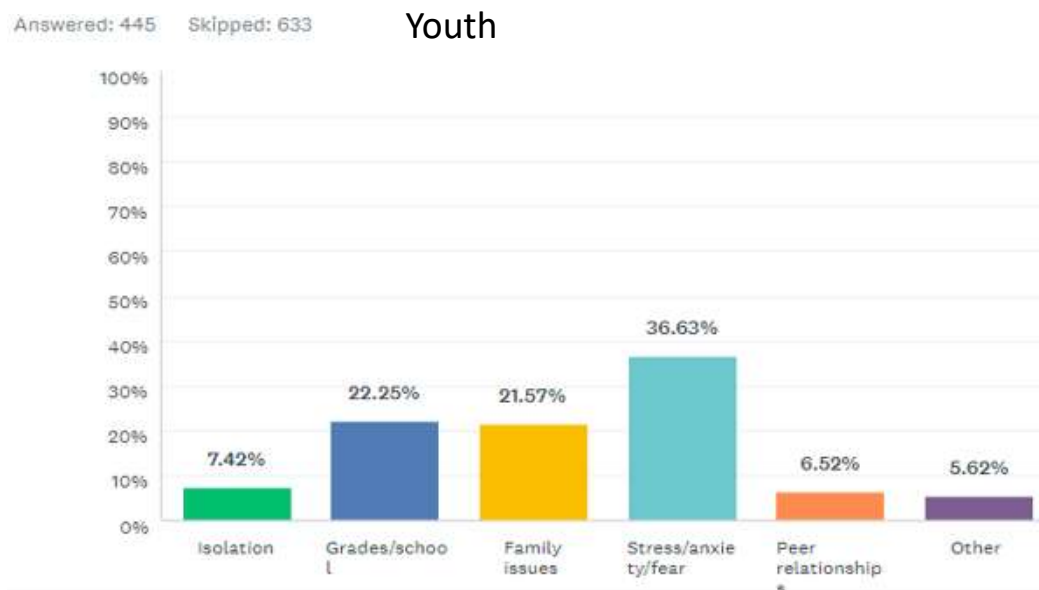
Do families have clear rules about alcohol and other drugs?

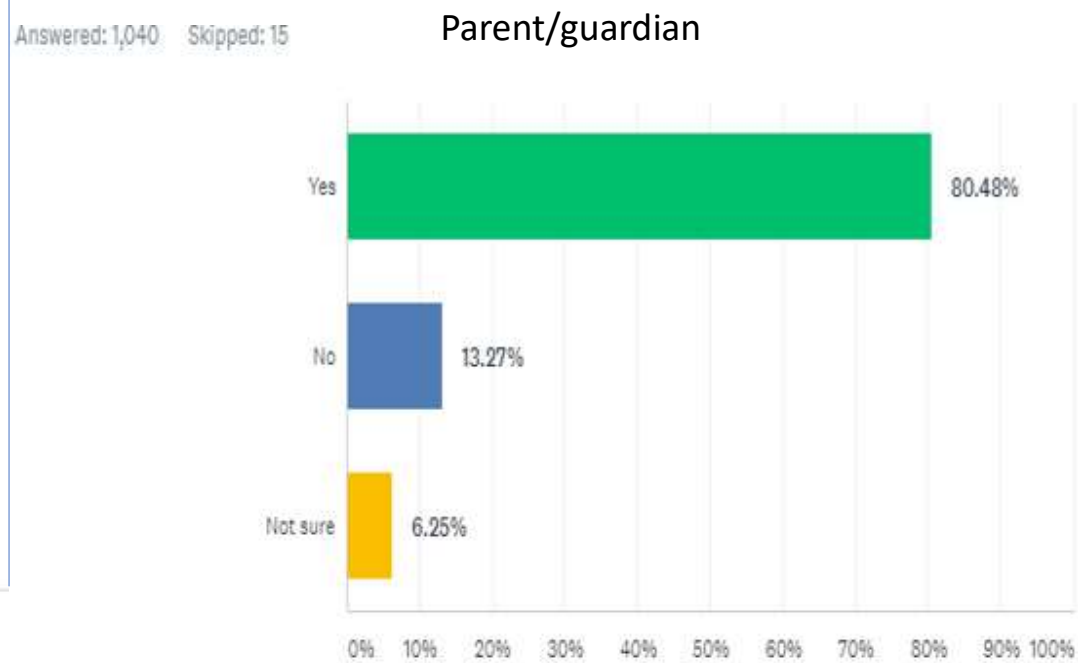
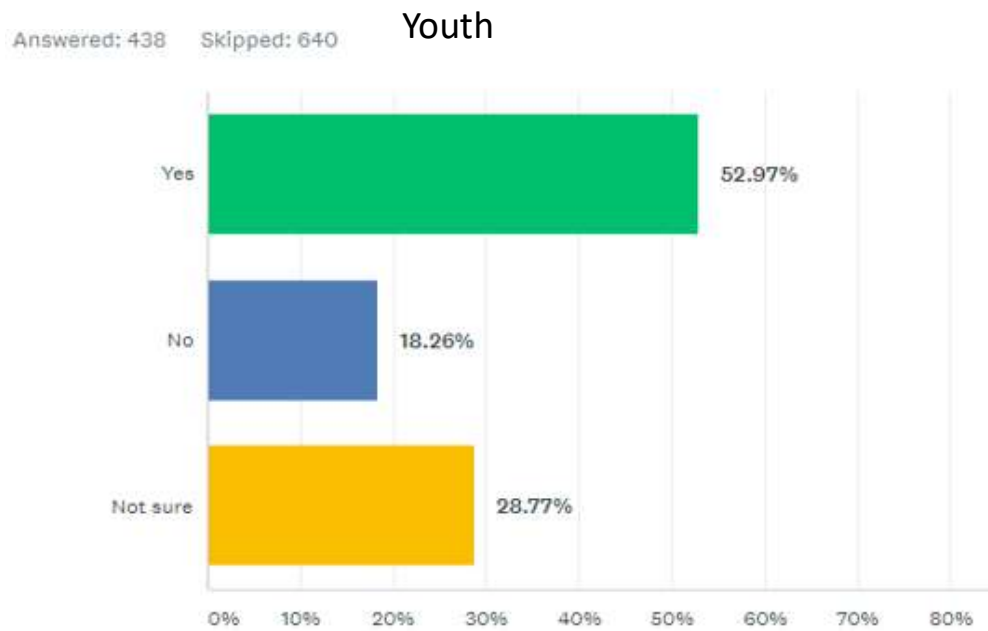

What are the main issues that impacts teen's mental health? (choose 2)



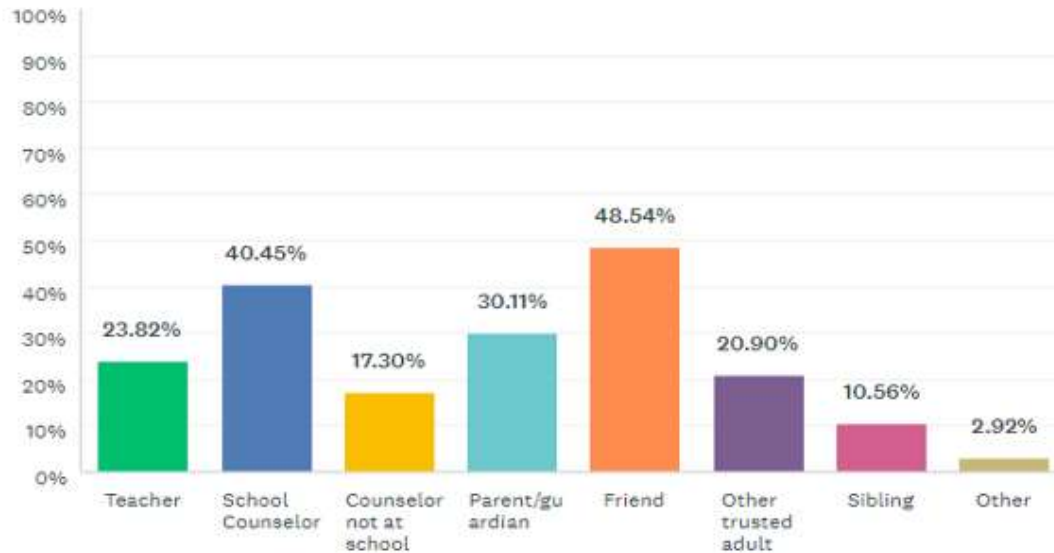
Do teens with mental health issues have someone to talk to about the issue?



Who would be the most likely person teens would talk to about mental health issue? (choose top 2)

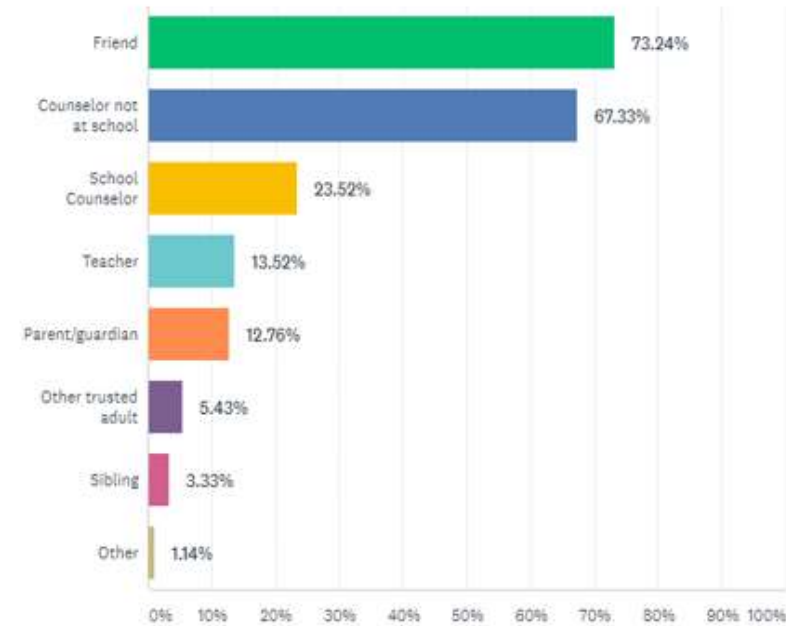

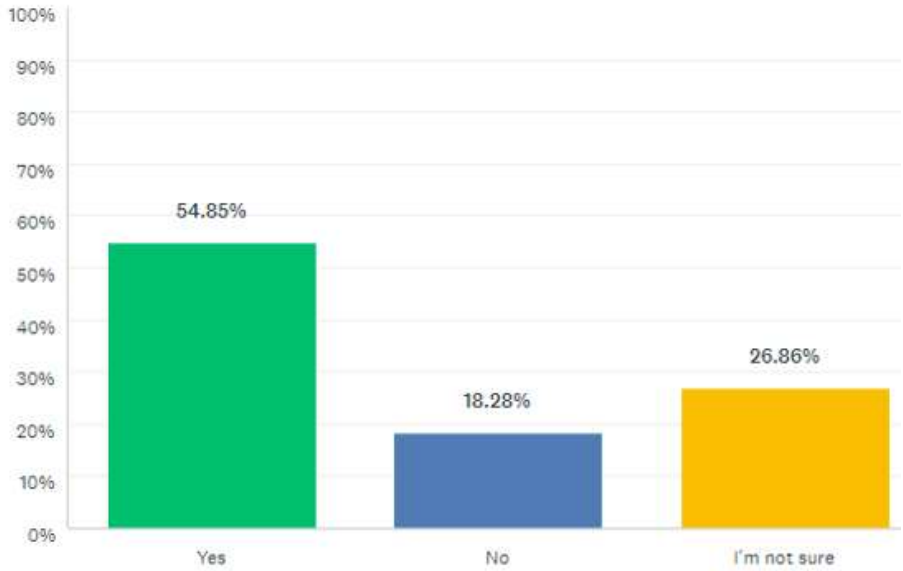

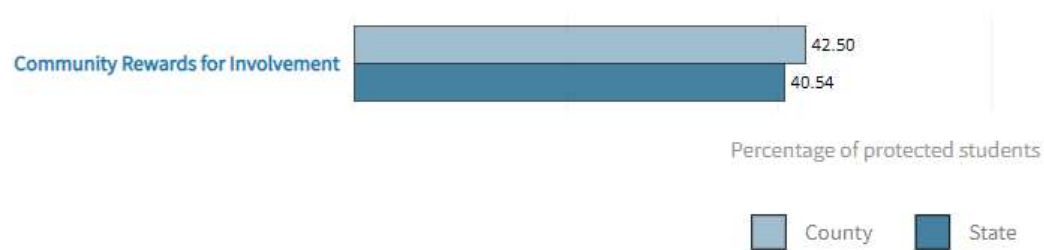

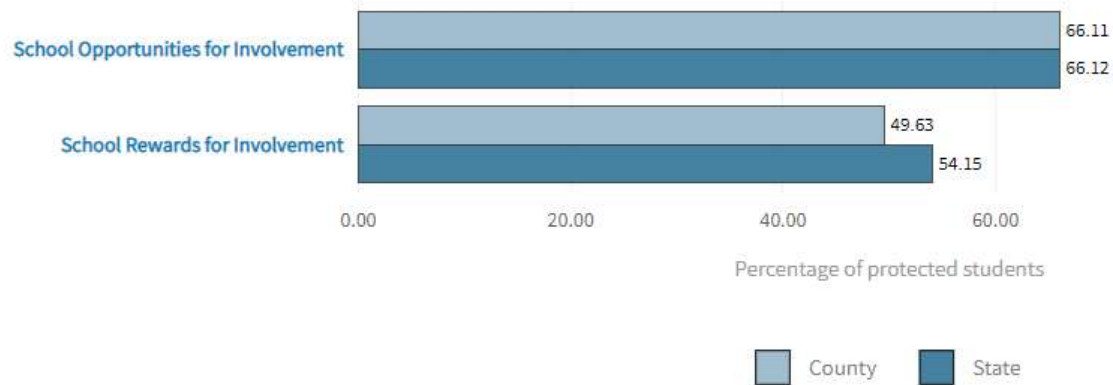

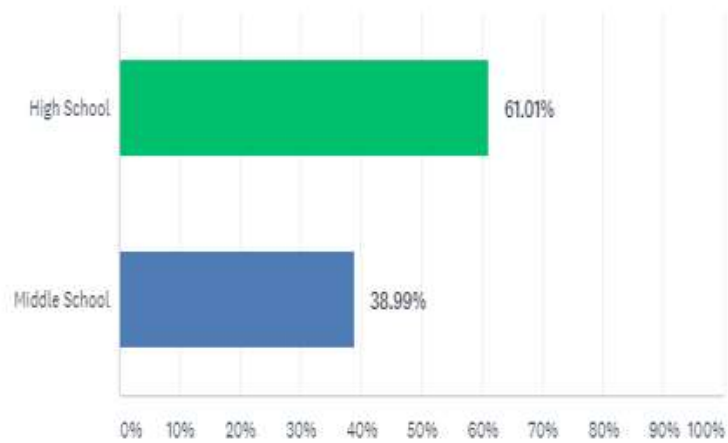
